Uniform Policy

General

The school uniform is provided by the school store and it should be acquired prior to the beginning of the school.

All clothing must be neat, clean and acceptable in appearance.

All students are to be groomed and dressed appropriately for school and school activities. A student's dress and/or appearance shall:

1. Support, not disrupt the learning environment
2. Be tasteful and unable to be construed as proactive or obscene.
3. Reflect practice of good hygiene and cleanliness.

The school Uniform:

Foundation Stage to IGCSE:

Boys

- Shirt-Green/off white checked
- Trousers-Beige
- Shoes-Plain Black leather
- Belt-Plain Black (No Fancy Buckle)
- Socks-Plain white
- Blazer-Bottle Green

Girls

- Skirt-Beige Pinafore (juniors)
- Ankle length shirt-Beige (Senior)
- Blouse-Green /off white checked
- Waistcoat-Beige (Seniors-Gr.5 above)
- Shoes-Plain White
- Ribbon-/Hairband-Black
- Blazer-Black Green
- Hijab-Black (Scarf) for Muslim Girls



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Need to mention

- P.E Uniform only to be worn on specific day (i.e P.E lessons)
- Senior Jackets
- Different coloured T-shirts (inner) are not permitted.
- It is compulsory to wear stockings/inner tights under the shirt (Girls).

All shirts should be buttoned up and tucked in properly. Sleeves should be kept rolled down and buttoned at the cuffs. Trousers should be belted properly at the waist and NOT be kept low.

Headwear and Hair

- Hats are not to be worn at school except for the field trips where they should be plain and simple.
- Haircuts or hair styles which draw undue attention to the wearer are not permitted. Multi – coloured or unnatural coloured hair is not allowed. Spikes and hair gel are also not permitted.
- Boys hair should be neatly trimmed uniformly to ensure that the ears and forehead is not covered. The length of the hair should not extend beyond the nape of the neck.
- Girls hair should not cover the forehead and if longer than the shoulders, it should be neatly braided.
- Girls wearing Hijabs use only plain black or white hijab, neatly tied and should worn meeting its purpose
- Girls wearing Abaya should wear plain black Abaya with no adornments over the school uniform.

Cosmetics

Use of cosmetics, body paint and Nail Polish is strictly prohibited.

Permissible Jewellery for Girls

Earrings worn by girls should only be studs. No long earrings are allowed.



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Any other items of jewellery such as rings, necklaces, wristbands or ankle bands are not permitted. Sunglasses are not to be worn in classrooms or offices.

Other

Mobile phones, music players, **Personal Digital Assistants** (PDAs) are not allowed at school. Only in the case of emergency, a mobile phone may be brought to but will have to be deposited at the office of Head of School/class teacher.

However, the school does not take any responsibility for loss or damage of these items.

The possession of skateboards / skates / roller blades / scooters/and bikes and their use is prohibited at school.

Students are required to bring a school bag, relevant books, pencil case and homework diary to school each day.

This Policy is reviewed by the Senior Management Team. It was last reviewed in August 2016, and will be next reviewed in August 2019.
