Al-Nujoom Awards: Statement of Position, Judgement and Presentation Protocol

- **Definition:**

Al Nujoom Awards are special honours and accolades bestowed on teachers and students for their outstanding contribution to the teaching learning process and showing extra ordinary skills and attitudes, even outside their purview of work. These awards were primarily embodied for the students showing skills in academics, which has now been extended to teachers and also students regularly attending school in the course of an Academic year.

- **Statement of Position**

The Oxford School, Dubai believes in the good old policy of rewarding rather than punishing. A student would show his skills and formulate his attitude in cases where his behaviour is awarded. The school firmly believes rewards to be a strong stimulant to performance

- **Categories for Judgement**

- ⚡ **Al Nujoom Scholar** : 90% and more in 5 or more Subjects
- ⚡ **Al Nujoom Award** : Subject topper for a particular Grade

- ⚖ **100% Attendance Award:** Students who haven't missed even 1 working day.
- ⚖ **Best Teacher Award :** Award for the teacher adjudged the best at each phase.

• Judgement and Presentation Protocol

- ⚡ Consolidated Performance of all the 3 terms shall form the basic criteria for judgement to be awarded the Al Nujoom Award.
- ⚡ Only pupils who have appeared for all Examinations conducted during the course of the academic year will be eligible for the award.
- ⚡ Al Nujoom Scholar is awarded to pupils scoring above 90% marks in 5 subjects or more.
- ⚡ Al Nujoom Award for the subject topper will be given to pupils who have got 90% and more in that particular subject for a particular class.
- ⚡ All prizes shall be awarded at a special ceremony Al Nujoom Awards Night.
- ⚡ The Toppers at GCE and IGCSE shall be felicitated on the same criteria as Al Nujoom Scholars and Subject toppers.
- ⚡ A student who remains Present on all working days of the School year, shall be awarded a special Prize for his attitude towards Punctuality and Attendance.
