UNIFORM POLICY

General

The school store provides the school uniform, and it should be acquired prior to the beginning of the school.

All clothing must be neat, clean, and acceptable in appearance.

All students are to be groomed and dressed appropriately for school and school activities. A student's dress and/or appearance shall:

1. Support, not disrupt the learning environment
2. Be well-dressed to avoid proactive or obscene image.
3. Reflect the practice of good hygiene and cleanliness.

The school Uniform:

Foundation Stage to IGCSE: Boys

- Shirt-Green/off white checked
 - Trousers-Beige
 - Shoes-Plain Black leather
 - Belt-Plain Black (No Fancy Buckle)
 - Socks-Plain white
- Green and grey jacket for foundation and juniors
Black and grey jacket for seniors
Shoes as per the house rules (Physical education)

Girls

- Skirt-Beige Pinafore (juniors)
- Ankle length shirt-Beige (Senior)
- Blouse-Green /off white checked
- Waistcoat-Beige (Seniors-Gr.5 above)
- Shoes-As per the House rules (Physical Education)
- Ribbon/Hair band-Black
- Hijab-Black (Scarf) for Muslim Girls

Green and grey jacket (foundation stage and juniors)

Black and grey jacket (seniors)

Shoes: Plain, flat black leather

Socks: Plain white

Need to mention

- P. E Uniform only to be worn on a specific day (i.e. P.E class and Fun Trips) and during Educational Trips proper regular uniform shall be worn.
- Senior Jackets
- Different coloured T-shirts (inner) are not permitted.
- It is compulsory to wear stockings/inner tights under the skirt (Girls).

All shirts should be buttoned up and tucked in properly. Sleeves should be kept rolled down and buttoned at the cuffs. Trousers should be appropriately belted at the waist and NOT be kept low.

Headwear and Hair

- Hats are not to be worn at school except for the field trips where they should be plain and simple.
- Haircuts or hairstyles which draw undue attention to the wearer are not permitted. Multi-coloured or unnatural coloured hair is not allowed. Spikes and hair gel are also not permitted.
- Boys hair should be neatly trimmed uniformly to ensure that the ears and forehead is not covered. The length of the hair should not extend beyond the nape of the neck.
- Girls hair should not cover the forehead, and if longer than the shoulders, it should be neatly braided.
- Girls wearing Hijabs use only plain black hijab, neatly tied and should be worn meeting its purpose
- Girls wearing Abaya should wear plain black Abaya with no adornments over the school uniform.

Cosmetics

Use of cosmetics, body paint and Nail Polish is strictly prohibited.

Permissible Jewelry for Girls

Earrings worn by girls should only be studs. No long earrings are allowed.

Any other items of jewellery such as rings, necklaces, wristbands, or ankle bands are not permitted. Sunglasses are not to be worn inside the classrooms or school premises.

Other

Mobile phones, music players, **Personal Digital Assistants (PDAs)** are not allowed at school. Only in the case of emergency, a mobile phone may be brought but will be deposited at their respective Section Head office/class teacher.

However, the school will not take any responsibility for any loss or damage of these items.

The possession of skateboards/skates/rollerblades/scooters/and bikes and their use is prohibited at school.

Students are required to bring a school bag, relevant books, pencil case and homework diary to school each day.

Exemptions/Non-Compliance to school uniform policy:

Students who are unable to meet the uniform policy on any particular day must bring a written notice from their parent stating a valid explanation for non-compliance with the school uniform requirements. The appropriate notice must be submitted to School Reception / Section Head prior to entering the class. Consideration of the exemption will be permitted if the reason is acceptable.
